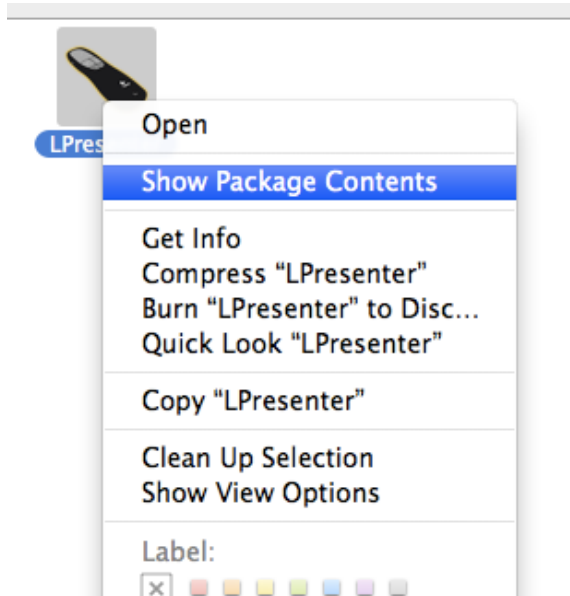
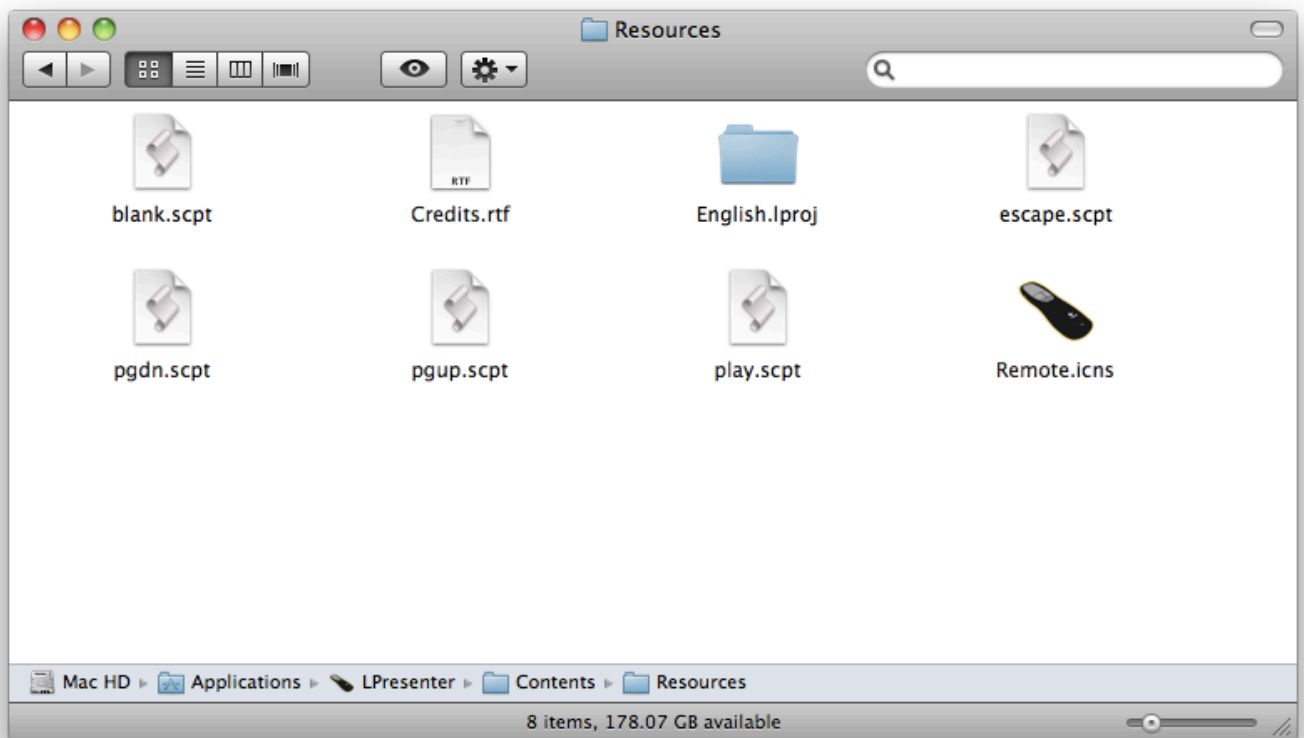


How to customize button behavior in LPresenter

1. Locate LPresenter application in Finder.
2. Right click or ctrl-click on it to open context menu.
3. Click on "Show Package Contents" to open .



4. Go to folder "Contents" > "Resources", you would find a few .sct (applescript) files.



Each of the .scpt file corresponds to a button on the remote:

blank.scpt	action for the black screen key
escape.scpt	action for Play/Stop button to stop slideshow
pgdn.scpt	action for the '<' key
pgup.scpt	action for the '>' key
play.scpt	action for Play/Stop button to start slideshow

You may change these script to suit your needs. For example, if you want to pause your slideshow when Play/Stop button is pressed instead of to quit it then edit the "escape.scpt" (just double-click it to open Applescript Editor).

original escape.scpt (send escape to Keynote when Stop is pressed)

```
tell application "System Events"  
    tell application "Keynote" to activate  
        key code 53  
end tell
```

modified escape.scpt (send "F" key to Keynote when Stop is pressed)

```
tell application "System Events"  
    tell application "Keynote" to activate  
        keystroke "f"  
end tell
```
